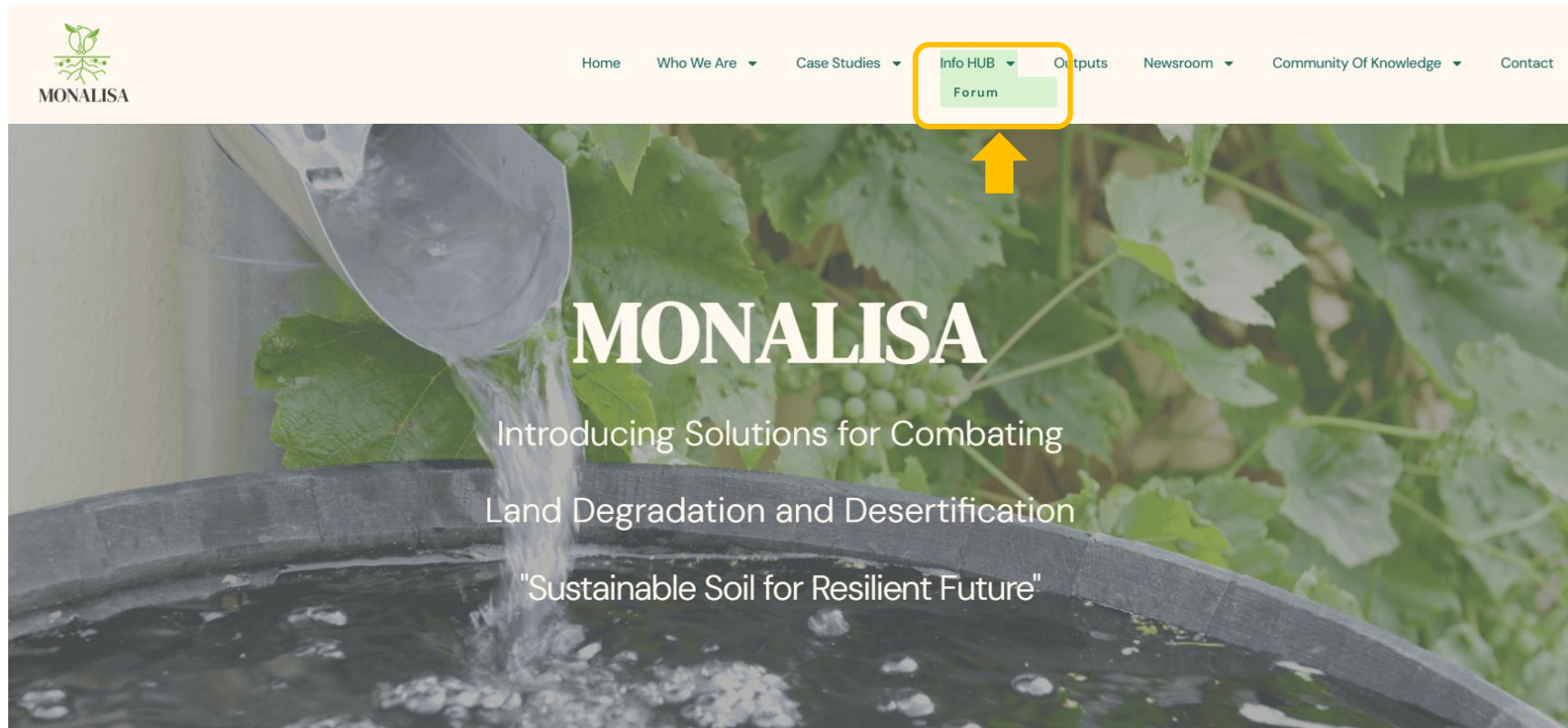

STEP 3. LOGIN

On the login page, users can login if they already have registered, using their Username and Password. If you are a first time user go to **Create Account** button bellow.

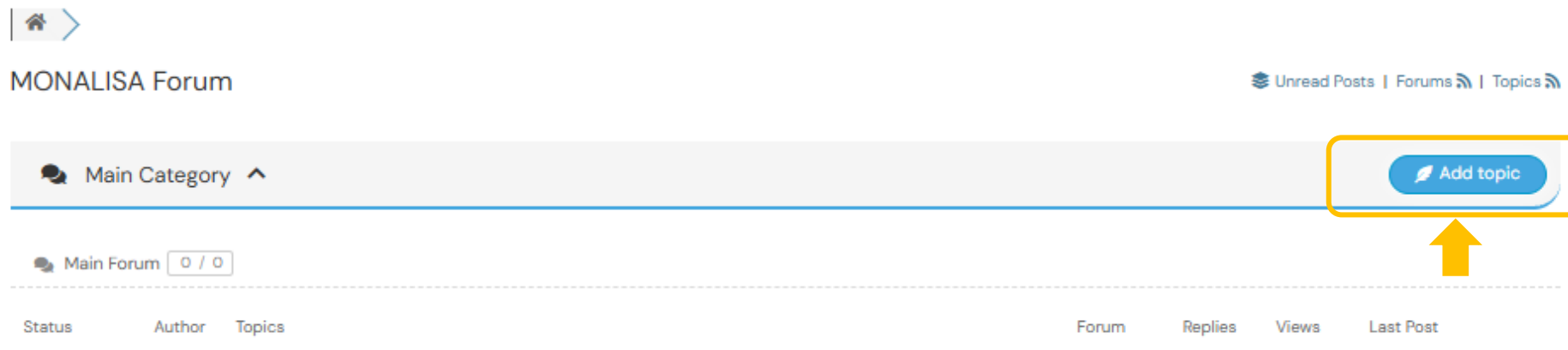
STEP 3.1 Registration

Enter selected **Username** and your **email address**. **Check all the necessary boxes** (human confirmation, Privacy Policy and registration email) and proceed to click the button **Register**. After registration, as soon as our administrators confirm that account is legitimate you will receive the confirmation on you email account with further instructions for account activation.



STEP 4. ADD A NEW TOPIC

STEP 4.1 Click on a Add topic button as shown in the photo below



STEP 4.2 Type in the **Topic Title, Description** etc.

The Forum offers the text formatting tools for user to format text and add links, emojis and documents.

The maximum allowable size for a document is 10MB.

Also users can make the topic **STICKY** or **PRIVATE**. **Sticky** topic is going to be pinned on top of the forum.

Users can **subscribe** to a specific topic of the forum.

Tags will allow better filtering of the topics and replies through the website and are not mandatory.



In the end users need to click on the button **ADD TOPIC** shown in the following photo.


